- Proven experience teaching ESL to adults, preferably in a community-based setting.
- Strong understanding of adult learning principles and second language acquisition.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to adapt teaching methods to meet the diverse needs of learners.
- Proficiency in Spanish or another language spoken by the community (required).
